Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for the Tucson Mountain Park Waterline in Fiscal Year 2027.

The entity to receive funding for this project is the Pima County, located at 130 W. Congress St., Tucson, AZ 85701.

The funding would be used for the replacement of a critical water conveyance system that delivers water to all major public uses in Tucson Mountain Park, a flagship natural resources park adjacent to Sahuaro National Park. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will serve the broader southern Arizona community, including the Arizona Sonora Desert Museum, Tucson Mountain Park Picnic Areas, Old Tucson theme park and a popular archery range.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by section 595 of the Water Resources Development Act of 1999 (PL 106-53), as amended.
