I am requesting funding for the Potable Water Storage Project in Fiscal Year 2027.

The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Tolleson located at 9055 W. Van Buren St. Tolleson, AZ 85353.

The funding would be used for constructing a new two-million-gallon potable water storage tank within the City's drinking water system. This project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will allow utilities to meet peak flow demands, maintain system pressure, provide fire protection capacity, and ensure uninterrupted delivery of treated water during outages or maintenance events.
